Policy Statement

1. Aims

2. Objectives

The objectives of the Moot Court Club are:

1. To develop advocacy, drafting, and legal research skills among students.
2. To familiarize students with court etiquette, procedures, and professional conduct.
3. To encourage participation in intra-college, inter-collegiate, national, and international moot court competitions.
4. To bridge the gap between theoretical legal education and practical application of law.
5. To promote teamwork, analytical thinking, and effective communication skills.
6. To provide training and mentorship through workshops, practice sessions, and interactions with legal professionals.
7. To uphold ethical standards and discipline in all moot court-related activities.

3. Policy Statement

The Moot Court Club of the New Law College is committed to providing an inclusive, disciplined, and academically enriching environment that promotes excellence in legal advocacy and research.

- Members

4.3 Responsibilities of office bearers

- President: To preside over meetings, maintain the protocol, represent the Club, ensure smooth functioning, and coordinate with Students Bar Association
- Vice President: To assist in planning and execution of activities
- Secretary: To maintain records, correspondence, minutes of meetings, conduct activities
- Joint secretary: To assist the secretary, administer the policy decisions of MCC
- Treasurer: To manage funds responsibly and maintain financial record with transparency

5. Standard Operating Procedure (SoP)

- a) Organize special coaching/training to members on a daily basis.
- b) Arrange internal moot court/moot trial/ judgment writing / debates every week.
- c) Conduct internal competitions and choose best team for outdoor competition.
- d) Provide the financial assistance for participating in the competition.
- e) Encourage the participation in competitions and strive for the prizes.
- f) No discrimination among the students shall be made on any ground
- g) Abide by the rules of discipline of the college, university and BCI
